Active Systems

Several tropical waves continue to track across the Atlantic Basin; however, tropical development is not expected with any of these waves. Conditions remain favorable for development across the Tropical Atlantic near the Intertropical Convergence Zone south of 10N. Despite these favorable conditions, tropical development will be unlikely due to the lack of any significant convection. Favorable conditions for tropical development are also noted across the eastern Gulf of Mexico, Florida Straits and western Atlantic. However, model guidance does not develop any areas of low pressure across these regions over the next seven days. Elsewhere, unfavorable conditions will prevail under a ridge of high pressure.
