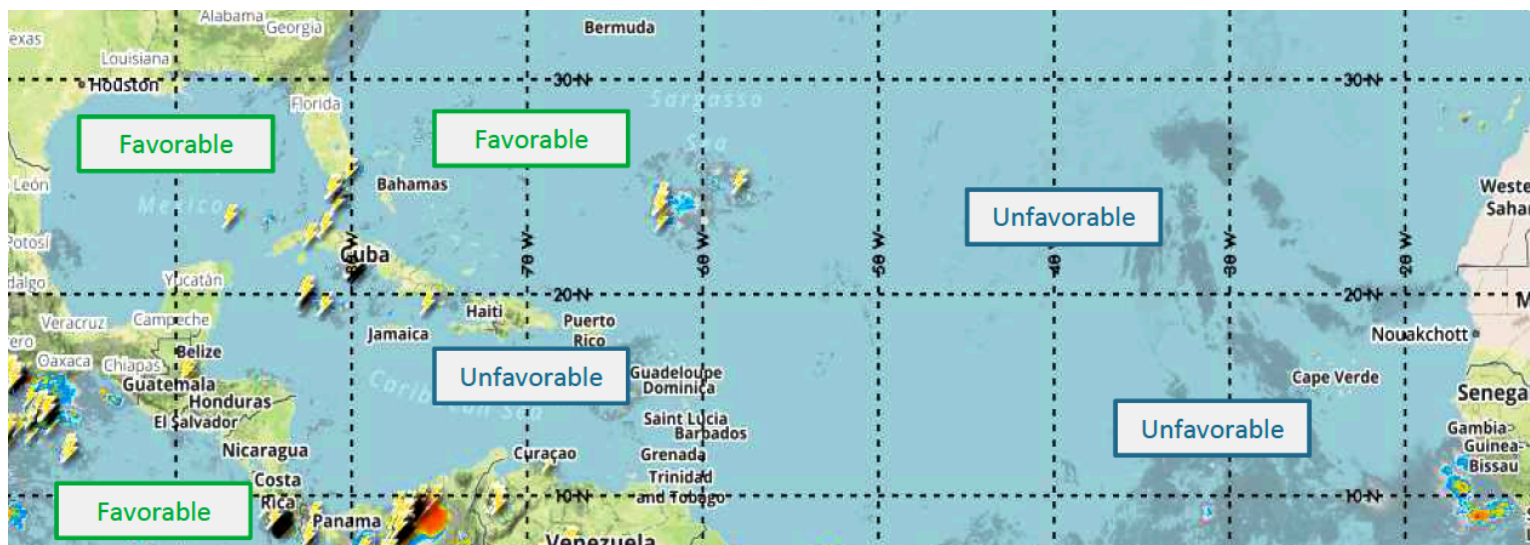

Favorable conditions for tropical development, i.e., low wind shear and warm sea surface temperatures, persist across the Gulf of Mexico and northeast of the Bahamas. Unfavorable conditions are noted across the Caribbean Sea, along with eastern and central Atlantic with strong wind shear along with elevated levels of Saharan dust.

Currently, there are no notable disturbances of interest. Tropical development is not forecast over the next seven days.
