Active Systems

Analyses continue to show waves marching across the equatorial Atlantic and into the Caribbean, however, model guidance is not showing any of them developing. Conditions in the region from Africa westward toward the Caribbean and into the Gulf of Mexico continue to be largely unfavorable, mostly because of high shear and dry air. Model guidance is suggesting that shear may start to gradually lower over parts of this region over the next several days. Although this does mean that conditions are slowly becoming more favorable, especially to the west where water temperatures are quite warm, models are also suggesting that dry air will remain in place. Therefore, tropical development is not expected over the next seven days.
