Our last posted inbound is for 2000 tonight and then we drop off until 0600 on Wednesday morning. At this time we have not diverted any vessel from SWP it has just happened naturally as most of our vessels are coming from the Florida area and await GORDON to diminish before proceeding.

As per the latest update from the NWS our staff will shelter in place at our station in Burrwood while operations remain in a normal staus in order to get as many vessels moved to safe berths while we still have good weather. We will be closely monitoring the intensity, track and closest point of approach to determine if necessary when conditions are no longer safe to move within the harbor. As stated earlier this system has a very small wind field and a small jog to the west or east could make a ton of difference.
