The Carrollton Gage in New Orleans has reached twelve (12) feet. Effective at 12:00 p.m. today, December 14, 2018, NOBRA will implement the following restriction as mandated by the Board of Examiners:

Mooring and unmooring operations at all mid-stream transfer facilities and any berth that requires the use of a mooring boat shall be restricted to daylight hours.

This high-water restriction will be in effect until the Carrollton Gage reaches twelve (12) feet and falling.
