Effective February 20, 2018, vessel agents will have the ability to submit notices of vessel arrivals to the CBP New Orleans Operations Desk via e-mail using the guidelines established below:

- 1. An email box named <u>neworleansopsdesk@cbp.dhs.gov</u> has been established for vessel arrival notifications and updates.
- 2. Notifications shall be submitted to CBP on the attached Word Template, or via text email in the exact format on the template.
- 3. The e-mail subject line should be formatted as applicable below:
  - a. ARRL Vessel Name
  - b. UPDATE Vessel Name
- 4. The update emails should include all details of the original notice with changes notated in the <u>Updates</u> box. Please add new updates in sequential order if multiple updates are required while in port.
- 5. This email notification to CBP New Orleans does not relieve the trade from any vessel arrival notice currently required to CBP Gramercy or CBP Baton Rouge.

Of note: Vessel agents may continue to provide notice of vessel arrivals, and updated vessel arrival information, to the CBP New Orleans Operations Desk **telephonically** during the hours of 0700 - 1500 hours Sunday – Saturday, via telephone number (504) 670-2270.
