Charenton Floodgate		N/A	Closed until further notice.	This structure was closed in 2005.
Bayou Boeuf Lock		De-watering for gate replacement	04 Sep 2018	Beginning at sunrise on 04 September 2018, Bayou Boeuf Lock will close to navigation 24hrs per day until approximately 15 October 2018 in order to install gates and make necessary repairs and adjustments.
Calcasieu Lock	18-99	Chamber Guide Wall work	21 May 2018	Calcasieu Lock will be closed to navigation intermittently Monday through Thursday from 6:30 am until 6:30 pm each day or as indicated by the Corps. This schedule will continue until approximately 1 December 2019.
Bayou Sorrel Lock	18-110	Dewatering Gate repairs	31 August 2018	Commencing on approximately 31 August 2018 and continuing until approximately 30 November 2018, Bayou Sorrel Lock will be closed to navigation 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, due to dewatering operations at the south end gates.
Old River Lock	18-112	Emergency Bulkhead Lowering System repairs	27 August 2018	Commencing on or about 27 August 2018 and continuing through 07 September 2018, mariners will be subject to delays to navigation (up to 12 hours) at Old River Lock. The delays will occur during daylight hours between 7 am to 7 pm. due to repairs of the lock's emergency bulkhead lowering system.
