## LOW WATER SAFETY ADVISORY: LMR MM 225 TO MM 228.3

As a result of the Baton Rouge gauge reading <u>16 feet and below</u>, the COTP New Orleans has issued a Safety Advisory from Mile Marker (MM) 225 to MM 228.3, Lower Mississippi River (LMR). This advisory is effective <u>Monday</u>, <u>July 04</u>, <u>2022 at 6:00 a.m.</u> The following are recommendations for the advisory:

1. All towing vessels in the vicinity of <u>College Town Light (MM 225 to MM 228.3)</u> are advised to keep flat on the bank and provide a wide berth to deep-draft vessel traffic.
