

SAFETY FAIRWAY DIVING OPERATIONS

Mariners are advised that commencing on August 5, 2022 and continuing through August 9, 2022, Chet Morrison Contractors will be conducting diving operations in support of pipeline remediation where safety fairways converge approximately 5 miles South to the entrance of South West Pass at position Lat: 28°47'53.83" N, Lon: 89°25'46.99" W.

M/V CROSBY ENDEAVOUR and SUBSEA VISION BARGE will be anchored and restricted in their ability to maneuver inside the Safety Fairway until the operation is complete. The vessel will be displaying dive flag, day shapes, navigational lights, and eight deployed anchors will be marked w/surface buoys. The vessel will be monitoring VHF-FM Channel 16 in support of local traffic.

Mariners are urged to use caution when transiting the area and <u>shall keep a minimum one-half (0.5) mile</u> <u>closest point of approach radius around the vessels anchored position</u>.
