<u>Safety Advisory - Port Allen-Morgan City Alternate Route</u> Closure due to Dredging Operations at MM 34 GIWW

The Captain of the Port New Orleans is issuing a safety advisory for the waters of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway Mile Marker 34. This advisory is needed to protect persons and vessels from the potential safety hazards associated with the dredging operations occurring in the area. The Port Allen-Morgan City Alternate Route will be closed at MM 34 from 0600-1800, October 1, 2022 to October 4, 2022. Mariners are urged to remain vigilant and proceed at the slowest safe speed to minimize wake in the area when traffic is permitted on these days.
