LOW WATER SAFETY ADVISORY: LMR MM 167 TO MM 303 (16' and below)

1. As a result of the Baton Rouge gauge reading <u>16 feet and below</u>, the COTP New Orleans has issued a Safety Advisory from Mile Marker (MM) 225 to MM 228.3, Lower Mississippi River (LMR). This safety advisory is effective immediately with the following provisions:

- A. All towing vessels in the vicinity of <u>College Town Light (MM 225 to MM 228.3)</u> are advised to keep flat on the bank and provide a wide berth to deep-draft vessel traffic.
- 2. Report missing aids to navigation to the Sector New Orleans Command Center.

3. This Marine Safety Information Bulletin <u>supersedes</u> Volume XXII, <u>Issue 064</u>, <u>Low Water Safety Advisory: MM</u> 167 to MM 303 AHP LMR (12' and below).
