## **LOW WATER SAFETY ADVISORY:** LMR MM 167 TO MM 303 (16' and below)

- 1. As a result of the Baton Rouge gauge reading 16 feet and below, the COTP New Orleans has issued a Safety Advisory from Mile Marker (MM) 225 to MM 228.3, Lower Mississippi River (LMR). This safety advisory is effective immediately with the following provisions:
  - A. All towing vessels in the vicinity of College Town Light (MM 225 to MM 228.3) are advised to keep flat on the bank and provide a wide berth to deep-draft vessel traffic.
- 2. Report missing aids to navigation to the Sector New Orleans Command Center.
