Algiers Canal Closure - GIWW MM 2.7 Power Transmission Line Reconstitution - Update 1

On April 26, 2024 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Algiers Canal will be closed to all marine vessel traffic between MM 2.3 and MM 3.0 to allow Entergy to reconstitute a new transmission line at MM 2.7. Vessels intending to transit through the Algiers Lock shall check in with the Lock Master on VHF FM Ch. 14 or at 504-354-1861 for lock assignment and staging prior to closure times. During the closure, Algiers Lock will remain in operation to clear the queue staged between MM 2.3 and the lock.
