### LOW WATER SAFETY ADVISORY: LMR MM 167 to MM 303 (16' and Falling)

- 1. As a result of the Baton Rouge gauge reading <u>16 feet and below</u>, the COTP New Orleans has issued a Safety Advisory provision from Mile Marker (MM) 225 to MM 228.3, Lower Mississippi River (LMR). This safety advisory is effective immediately with the following provisions in accordance with the Waterways Action Plan Baton Rouge Annex:
  - a. All towing vessels in the vicinity of <u>College Town Light (MM 225 to MM 228.3)</u> are advised to keep flat on the bank and provide a wide berth to deep-draft vessel traffic.
- 2. Report missing aids to navigation to the Sector New Orleans Command Center.
