SUBJECT: Change of Location for CBP Services for Mardi Gras Season 2022

Saturday and Sunday, February 19-20, 2022
Saturday and Sunday, February 26-27, 2022
Tuesday, March 1, 2022

On the dates listed above, the CBP offices located on the Customhouse first floor, 423 Canal Street, Suite 186, **will temporarily relocate** due to traffic congestion associated with Mardi Gras 2022. On these dates, the CBP Marine Division, Operations Desk, PAU TET and ATU staff will relocate to the CBP Office at the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport [MSY].

All Marine Division functions will be performed at the airport during normal marine division hours: **7:30 AM – 4:00 PM.**

- Vessel formal entrance after arrival [48 hours] (19 CFR 4.3a);
- Filing complete manifests and export declarations [4 days] (19CFR 4.75b).
