**SUBJECT: Temporary Canal Street Parking Restrictions & Marine Division Early Closure Associated with the New Orleans Bayou Classic**

Advisory to the New Orleans trade community that the City of New Orleans has temporarily restricted parking on Canal Street *in front of the New Orleans Customhouse* effective Friday 11.25.22 at noon, thru Sunday morning 11.27.22. *See attached parking restrictions.*

**Due to anticipated traffic congestion downtown, the CBP Marine Division will close at 3:00 PM on Friday 11.24.22 and on Saturday 11.25.22.**
